Introduction

As part of Frenchville State School's commitment to providing a safe and supportive learning environment, the school has adopted a student dress code. Our dress code reflects the standards expected within the school community and ensures the best interests of the whole school community. The school uniform is viewed as integral in encouraging a sense of self-esteem, belonging and self-discipline in our students.

At Frenchville, we have one all-purpose school uniform which consists of a royal blue and white striped polo shirt and royal blue shorts or skirts. Students are expected to arrive at school in full uniform with the shirt tucked in.

This policy has been developed in accordance with the Education (General Provisions) Act 2006: Student Dress Code and Sun Safe Strategy in relation to implementing student dress codes in Queensland State Schools.

Sourcing our uniform

The Tuckshop Convenor stocks all items listed below for your convenience.

All-purpose uniform (*royal blue in colour with school logo)

Warmer months

- Striped polo shirt
- Mid-length shorts
- Combo skirt with bummers

Cooler months

- Zip front fleece jacket
- Tracksuit pants
- Full length leggings/tights (worn underneath skirt)

Shoes and socks

- Sneakers/joggers (lace-up or Velcro)
- Plain white sport socks (everyday wear)

Hat

- Reversible bucket hat (royal blue one side and house colour the other side)
- Royal blue broad-brimmed hat

For Inter-School Sports & Cultural Activities

Inter-School sport and cultural activity participation is not part of the core curriculum program. A condition of voluntary participation is that the prescribed uniform **must** be worn for games, competitions and events.

Softball and Tee Ball: All-purpose uniform

Cricket: All-purpose uniform

Netball: Uniform provided

Tennis: All-purpose uniform

Football: Uniform provided

Soccer: All-purpose royal blue shorts/skirt, shirt provided

Athletics: All-purpose uniform

Music: All-purpose uniform, **long white socks** (available at the Tuckshop), **black shoes** and royal blue ribbon (optional)

Jewellery

Jewellery is not to be worn or brought to school. For pierced ears or other body piercings, small studs only may be worn. The wearing of a religious cross or jewellery of personal or religious significance may be negotiated with a member of the leadership team. All jewellery must be removed before any form of sport. Medic alert bracelets are in exception and should be worn at all times.
